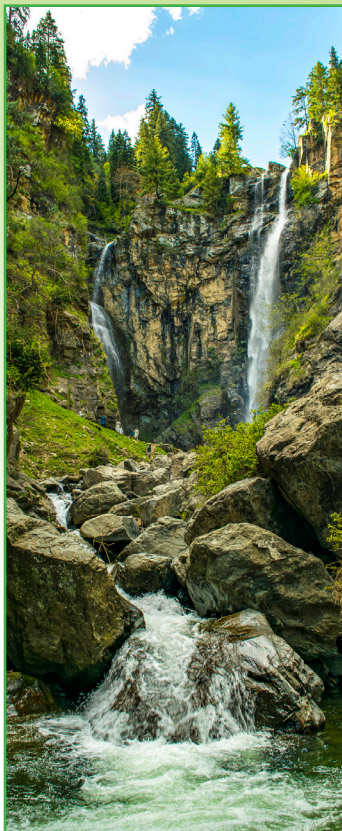
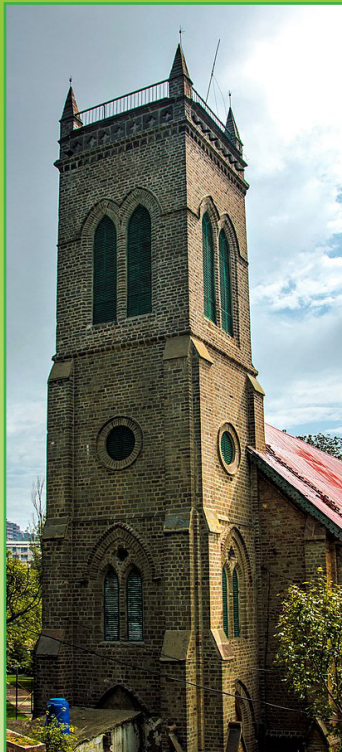
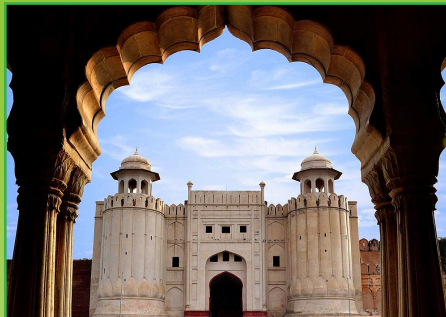


INTRIGUING FACTS

SPORTS

The sector exports goods worth USD 450m annually



PHARMACEUTICAL

LIVESTOCK

Livestock makes up 60% of agriculture and 11.7% of our GDP



CITRUS

Citrus fruit production of Pakistan stood at 2.3 million tonnes in 2020 growing at an average annual rate of 4.05% since 1971

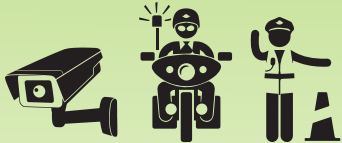

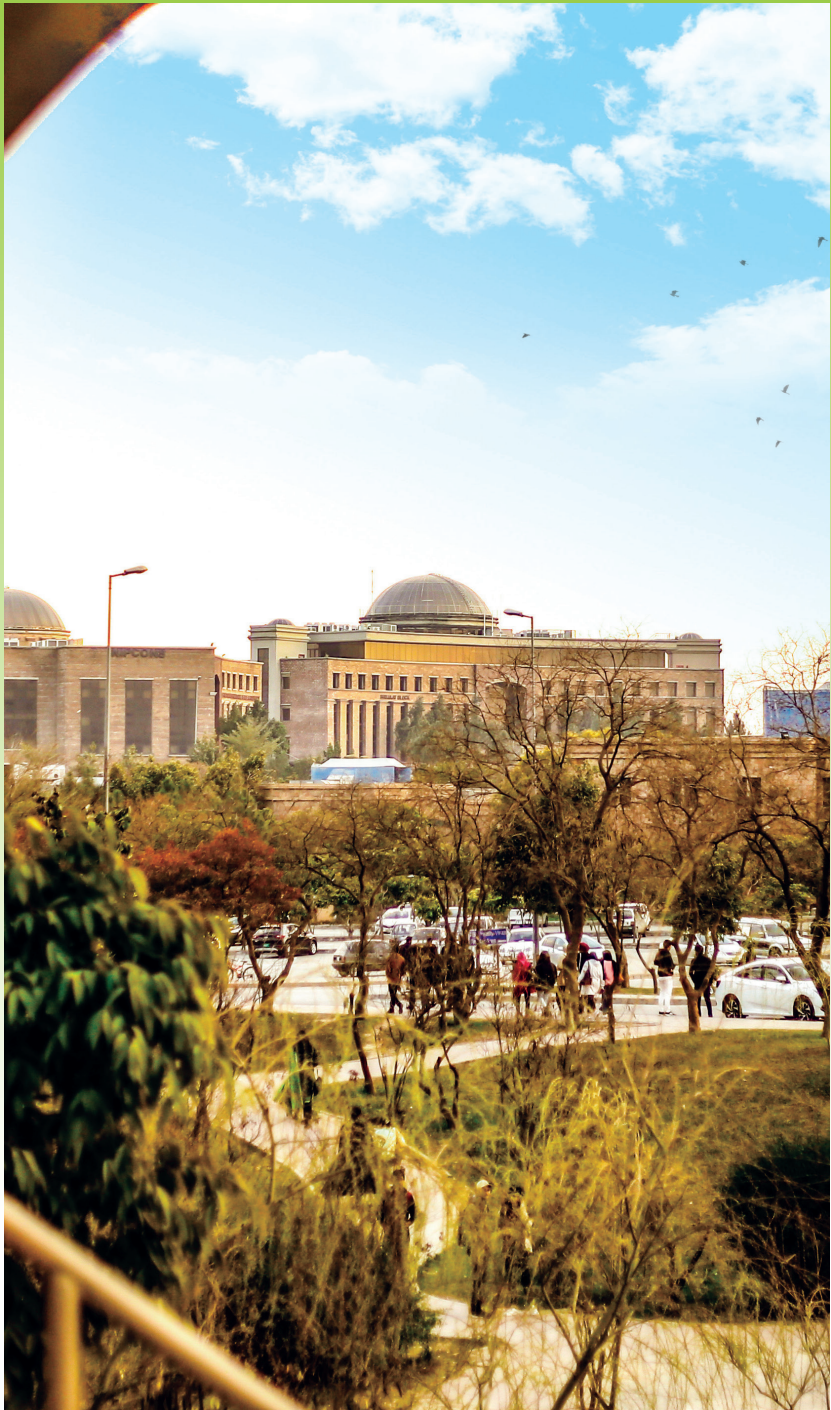
