



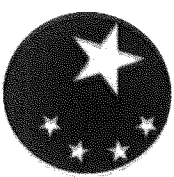

4. Ports & Shipping
5. Pharmaceuticals
6. Logistics & Transport
7. Renewable Energy (Solar cell technology)

The parties have agreed that China will support NUST for the following:

1. R&D in the sectors (as outlined above)
2. Cultural & Economic Partnerships

It was concluded that the understanding developed among people by working/studying together at the working level plays a fundamental role for any cooperation to succeed. Pakistan in general and NUST in particular offers very fluent English speaking technically qualified workforce in all major areas of engineering, medical sciences, business, finance and marketing etc. NUST proposes the following action plan to move forward in developing win-win arrangements of both countries organization's to succeed in the global competitive environment.

1. NUST has highly qualified and competent faculty trained from US and Europe universities which can be exchanged based on specific projects requirements or teaching at a collaborating partner Chinese university for a semester to one year duration.
2. Hold practical workshops in the areas of mutual interest to exchange knowledge and share expertise for execution of projects.
3. NUST can act as a regional hub in promoting capacity building and HR development.
4. Language brings the people more closely than any other relationship. We can jointly introduce bilingual programs starting September 2011. NUST will introduce Chinese language in its ICT program from September 2011. The support of three Chinese language teachers will be needed at NUST to jump start the program.
5. NUST will offer to host five Chinese students for internship in almost all the engineering disciplines at NUST. Similar number of Pakistani students will be accommodated in the Chinese universities, research centers/Industry.
6. Promote understanding of marketing and communication including Media relations.




