LAW-405 Corporate Law

Credit Hours: 3

Course Description

The course basically deals with the introduction of those commercial laws which are directly or indirectly related to Business. It includes a short study of contract law, partnership Act, companies' ordinance and negotiable instrument. The emphasis in this course is to introduce the students with the basic concepts of conventional business law and its implementation in the contemporary financial institutions.

Course Objectives

This course aims to achieve the following objectives:

- To understand the basic corporate structure, formation of companies and distinguish companies from other forms of business
- To understand the regulations and control by the government of corporate entities
- To provide an insight into corporate disputes and resolutions.
